





Located in Eastern Africa in the Mwanza region of Tanzania on the coast of Lake Victoria








The #1 problem the Village stated they

Women have to travel up to 5 miles each day collecting water...



























































And isolated growth on LVW and EMB agar after suction filtration







Temporary LifeStraw water filtration units were implemented




The education for water quality awareness was shared with men, wonten, and children...

Currently, the water system with the "best" quality only runs on occasion













And is considered "chlorine treated" because less than 1 cup of chlorine is added each month to this tank
